

# How to Install Floating Shelves – Step-by-Step Instructions

## Tools & Materials Needed

- Level
- Drill
- Screws + Wall Anchors
- Measuring Tape
- Pencil
- Wooden Shelves

### Step 1 — Measure and Mark Shelf Position

Use a measuring tape and level to mark a straight line where the shelf will sit. Ensure the line is perfectly level before moving to the next step.

### Step 2 — Locate Studs or Add Wall Anchors

Use a stud finder to locate studs behind the wall. If studs are not available where you need the shelf, insert heavy-duty wall anchors to support the weight.

### Step 3 — Install the First Bracket

Hold the bracket against the wall on your marked line and drill screws through the bracket holes into studs or anchors. Ensure the bracket is flush and secure.

### Step 4 — Install the Second Bracket

Use your level to ensure both brackets are perfectly aligned. Secure the second bracket with screws, ensuring equal height and spacing.

### Step 5 — Place the Shelf on the Brackets

Carefully position the wooden shelf on top of the installed brackets. Adjust until centered and balanced.

### Step 6 — Secure the Shelf with Screws

Using your drill, screw through the underside of the brackets into the wooden shelf to lock it into place. Check final stability and adjust if needed.










1. MEASURE AND MARK  
SHELF POSITION




2. LOCATE STUDS OR  
ADD WALL ANCHORS




3. INSTALL FIRST
